He was baptized into the Seventh-Day Adventist Church by Evangelist Dennis Ross, and Elder Lester, who was the Pastor at Magazine in 1987.

Currently, Elder Joseph Mallard serves as the Sabbath School Superintendent and Bible Study Teacher and Leader for New Believers and Incoming new members of the Church. " A young 5th grade girl asked if she could give me a nick name. She said "Sunshine Joe ". I asked why. She said "the Sunshine brings light and you do to, so I will call you Sunshine Joe ". That's how I got the name Sunshine Joe.

"Joseph "Sunshine Joe" Mallard: When I was in elementary school in Summit, Mississippi, I was a very skinny boy. Although I was very outgoing and seemed to have lots of friends, I was not good at playing sports. I remember when the other boys were choosing sides to play basketball or football, no one wanted me on their team. During those early years, I would walk home alone after school feeling rejected. I would always find my great, great grandmother, who was a former slave, sitting on the front porch making quilts. She used colorful pieces of fabric from flower sacks, old clothes and any material she could find. She never used a pattern, but she made some of the most beautiful bright colored quilts one could imagine. I watched her quilt every day. She would allow me to thread her needles and she would tell me stories about slavery."

My most recent quilt is in progress. The title of the quilt is "The other side of the American Dream." It addresses problems young people face in our society today. The word "Bullying" is front and center. Nearby is the image of a young man on a skateboard carrying a can of spray paint, ready to spread his message with graffiti. Words of reform are embroidered around the young man encouraging mercy and peace.
